Community Outreach

Part of the Emerge's mission is to make the arts accessible to the entire community. For every five paid programs, one is completely free and targeted towards at-risk or underprivileged youth. We do this through art programs geared towards those affected by cancer in the hospital, artist in residency programs, and our Youth Arts Initiative program, which includes scholarships and our Youth Public Arts Project.

Youth Public Arts Project is our longest running outreach program. This is a bi-weekly program where at-risk youth come to the arts council to work with professional artists and social work interns to create various public art projects. The public art is then displayed throughout the community.

Art is Good Medicine is an Arts in Healthcare program in partnership with local healthcare providers such as Vidant Health. Professional visual artists and dancers work with adult and pediatric cancer patients and survivors. In addition, we offer free workshops to cancer patients, survivors, family members, and caregivers.

Scholarships are offered to underprivileged children in our community to attend classes and workshops free of charge.

Registration Procedures

- · Payment may be made by check, cash, or credit card. If paying by credit card on a mailed registration, please fill in the address portion with your billing address as noted on your credit card statement.



Payment & Refund Policies

Payments & Refunds:

- Payments must be made in full deposits are not accepted.
- There will be NO refunds (full or partial) after five days prior to a class.
- Full refunds are available up to two weeks in advance, minus the processing fee of \$20. Full refunds must be requested in writing via mail, in person,

or via email to paula@pittcountyarts.org

 Partial Refunds are available after two weeks on a sliding scale up to five days prior to class and include the deduction of the processing fee of \$20.

The scale of what Emerge will retain if a cancellation occurs:

- 12 13 days prior 10% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 10 11 days prior 20% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 8 9 days prior- 30% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 7 days prior- 40% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 6 days prior 50% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 5 days prior 60% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- After 5 days prior no refund is given
- · In the case of emergency, sickness, or similar events, please contact Paula Rountree at Emerge Gallery & Art Center concerning your situation and need of a refund. Each situation is examined on an individual basis, and decisions are made by the education committee.
- In the event of any refund, the Emerge Gallery & Art Center will retain a \$20 processing fee.
- · Emerge does not offer makeup classes of any form for classes missed due to no fault of our organization. This includes switching classes or sessions.

Pottery Clubs

THE FIRING CIRCLE

Membership to THE FIRING CIRCLE is open to all current and previously enrolled students taking classes through our pottery program. If you have not taken a pottery class through Emerge, you must first enroll in the Clay Studio Orientation Class prior to joining THE FIRING CIRCLE. Members of the Firing Circle are paying only for the use of the kiln facilities. They are not eligible for use of the pottery facility including wheels, tables, equipment, etc. This is simply a club for those individuals who wish to create and owrk on their artwork off site, but need kiln usage. (Those wishing to use the Emerge Facility and supplies should enroll in Mudhole.) Clay and glazes are not included. Clay may be purchased at class rates. Clay not purchased at Emerge is not permitted. Dues run on a 6-month basis. Members pay for firing by drying room shelf load.

Membership Rates: \$25 for members, \$65 for non-members

Firing Rates: \$10 per drying room shelf

MUDHOLE

Membership to MUDHOLE is open to all current and previously enrolled students taking classes through our pottery program. Dues run on a 3-month or a 6-month basis. Membership entitles you to use our facilities any time during our open hours, whether you are currently enrolled in a class or not, the ability to purchase clay at class rates, use of glazes, and your work will be fired though our facility.

Eligibility: You must have taken at least 2 pottery classes at Emerge Gallery & Art Center. Your instructor must sign off on our Mudhole Waiver stating that you can wedge, center, trim and glaze successfully without supervision. If you are unable to do so, we will recommend you take another class prior to working alone and enrolling in Mudhole. *If you have pottery experience, but have not taken a class through our facility you must first enroll in the Clay Orintation Class prior to enrolling.

Ceramics & Pottery

Open Ceramics Studio

An amazing benefit of being enrolled in one of our pottery classes is that you can come in and work in the studio anytime during our open hours to gain extra practice! While camps and classes occupy the main studio during the summer, we have a satellite room that potters can work in.

Topics in Ceramics: May I be of service?

Tuesdays 6:00pm-8:30pm

Having friends over for dinner is fun; serving your friends dinner in pottery made by you is priceless. If you have ever considered making your own dinnerware, then this class is for you. Class exercises are designed to improve technical skills, increase throwing efficiency, and incorporate unifying features in a family of pots. This session is chockfull of tips on how to make multiples and provides lots of throwing instruction. Projects can be scaled to each potter's skill level and include: soup/cereal bowls, salad/dinner plates, and tumblers/mugs. We will be working in series; and, at the conclusion of the session, diligent potters will have one or more place settings. Potters should be able to center and pull 1-lb of clay.

Topics in Ceramics: Heels or Flats?

Tuesdays 6:00pm-8:30pm

Just as every girl knows that no outfit is complete without the right shoe, every potter knows how a proper foot completes a pot. In this session, we will explore the various options for the bottoms of pots. Discussions will include the technical and aesthetic concerns for making pots with and without feet. We will also consider other alternatives to trimming a foot because footless doesn't mean unfinished. This class is for you if you want to learn how to make good glaze lines, ensure your pot is stable, and make your pots more distinctive with just the right foot. Topics include: Footless pots; Trimmed feet; Altered feet; Added Feet. Potters should be able to center and pull 1-lb of clay.

Introduction to Wheel Throwing

Wednesdays 6:00pm-8:30pm

If you've never tried the potter's wheel but have always wanted to, then this class is for you. If you've thrown on the wheel before but need a refresher or are new to Emerge, then this class is for you too! During this introductory class, you will learn the fundamentals necessary for throwing cylinders and bowls. The session will focus on techniques for centering, opening, pulling, trimming, and glazing; and, by the end of the session, students will have several finished pots to take home. Class size is restricted so students can get the technical instruction required to establish a good foundation for continued learning. This class is a prerequisite for Continuing Pottery Classes. [Min. 4, Max. 6]

Continuing Potter: Beyond the Basics

Thursdays 6:00pm-8:30pm

Continuing students will hone their skills at centering, opening, and pulling during this 6 week class. Projects are designed to help improve the fundamentals necessary for crafting well-made cylinders and bowls. Advanced skills such as increasing scale, pulling spouts, and attaching handles will be addressed to challenge potters who have more wheel experience. Each project will include glazing and surface decoration discussions. This class is project driven and will allow students to take home several functional pieces! Introduction to Wheel Throwing is a prerequisite to this class. [Min. 6, Max. 8]

Open Metal Design Studio

As a benefit of enrollment in our metals program, current students are able to come in and work during our open studio hours currently scheduled for Tuesday evenings from 6:00pm until 8:30pm.

Metalsmithing Basics

"I made it myself!" That's what you'll tell friends when they ask about the unique piece of jewelry you're wearing. Learn metalsmithing techniques such as sawing, filing, soldering, and riveting to make a variety of projects. First-time participants will make a bracelet that involves all of these basic methods. Returning participants will work with the instructor to problem solve, refine their basic skills, and explore more advanced techniques such as enameling, etching, using alternative materials, and stone setting. [Min. 6, Max 7]
