COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Part of the Emerge's mission is to make the arts accessible to the entire community. For every five paid programs, one is completely free and targeted towards at-risk or underprivileged youth. We do this through art programs geared towards those affected by cancer in the hospital, artist in residency programs, and our Youth Arts Initiative program, which includes scholarships and our Youth Public Arts Project.

Youth Public Arts Project is our longest running outreach program. Started in 2005, this is a bi-weekly program, where at-risk youth come to the arts council to work with professional artists and musicians to create various public art projects and learn about the rich heritage of African American music. The public art is then displayed throughout the community.

Art is Good Medicine is an arts in healthcare program in partnership with local healthcare providers such as Vidant Health. Professional visual artists and dancers work with adult and pediatric cancer patients and survivors. In addition, we offer free workshops to cancer patients, survivors, family members, and caregivers and facilitate weekly art experiences at Hope Lodge.

Scholarships are offered to underprivileged children in our community to attend classes and workshops free of charge.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

You must fill out the registration form completely.

- We do not take phone registrations. Register early as space is limited!
- Registration is available via web, mail, or in person at our facility.

- Mailed registrations will be recorded by date of receipt.
- Payment may be made by check, cash, or credit card.

PAYMENT & REFUND POLICIES

Payments & Refunds:

- Payments must be made in full – deposits are not accepted.
- There will be NO refunds (full or partial) five days prior to a class.
- Full refunds are available up to two weeks in advance, minus the processing fee of \$20.
Full refunds must be requested in writing via mail, in person, or via email to paula@pittcountyarts.org
- Partial Refunds are available after two weeks on a sliding scale up to five days prior to class and include the deduction of the processing fee of \$20.

The scale of what Emerge will retain if a cancellation occurs:

- 12 - 13 days prior - 10% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 10 - 11 days prior - 20% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 8 - 9 days prior - 30% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 7 days prior - 40% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 6 days prior - 50% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 5 days prior - 60% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- After 5 days prior – no refund is given

- In the case of Emergency, sickness, or similar events, please contact Paula Rountree at Emerge Gallery & Art Center concerning your situation and need of a refund. Each situation is examined on an individual basis, and decisions are made by the education committee.
- In the event of any refund, the Emerge Gallery & Art Center will retain a \$20 processing fee.
- Emerge does not offer makeup classes in any form for classes missed due to no fault of our organization. This includes switching classes or sessions.



POTTERY CLUBS

THE FIRING CIRCLE

Membership to THE FIRING CIRCLE is open to all current and previously enrolled students taking classes through our pottery program. If you have not taken a pottery class through Emerge, you must first enroll in the Clay Studio Orientation Class prior to joining THE FIRING CIRCLE. Members of the Firing Circle are paying only for the use of the kiln facilities. They are not eligible for use of the pottery facility including wheels, tables, equipment, etc. This is simply a club for those individuals who wish to create and work on their artwork off site, but need kiln usage. (Those wishing to use the Emerge Facility and supplies should enroll in Mudhole.) Clay and glazes are not included. Clay may be purchased at class rates. Clay not purchased at Emerge is not permitted. Dues run on a 6-month basis. Members pay for firing by drying room shelf load.

Cost: \$25 for members, \$65 for non-members

Firing Rates: \$10 per drying room shelf – Must place receipt with potter’s name on drying room shelf in order to be fired

MUDHOLE

Membership to MUDHOLE is open to all current and previously enrolled students taking classes through our pottery program. Dues run on a 3-month or a 6-month basis. Membership entitles you to use our facilities any time during our open hours, whether you are currently enrolled in a class or not, the ability to purchase clay at class rates, use of glazes, and your work will be fired through our facility.

3 Month Membership: \$95 for members of Emerge, \$135 for non-members
6 Month Membership: \$145 for members of Emerge, \$185 for non-members

Eligibility: You must have taken at least 2 pottery classes at Emerge Gallery & Art Center. Your instructor must sign off on our Mudhole Waiver stating that you can wedge, center, trim and glaze successfully without supervision. If you are unable to do so, we will recommend you take another class prior to working alone and enrolling in Mudhole. *If you have pottery experience, but have not taken a class through our facility you must first enroll in the Clay Orientation Class prior to enrolling in Mudhole.

OPEN CERAMICS STUDIO

As a benefit of enrollment in our ceramics program, current students are able to come in and work during our open hours. If the main studio is in use, there is a satellite studio that is always open.

TOPICS IN CERAMICS: BOOT CAMP - BIG & TALL

It's Resolution Season and this is the time of year when everyone wants to lose weight, reduce debt, minimize clutter, etc. It seems like everyone wants to make things smaller. But not you! You want to get bigger...pots. So if your New Year's Goal is to make larger pots, this is the class for you. We will dedicate 6 weeks to work through a series of exercises and techniques designed to help you make bigger and taller pots than you currently are making. But bigger is only better if the pot is well thrown. So class demonstrations and discussions will address good and efficient throwing techniques. Potters should be able to center and pull 2lbs of clay. [Min. 6, Max. 8]

TOPICS IN CERAMICS: SURFACE DECORATION SURVEY

Do you want to enhance your pots and add more visual and tactical depth? Then this survey of surface decorative techniques may be just what you need to inspire you to make pots distinctively your own. We will focus on one surface decorating option at each phase of the ceramic process: wet, leather hard, and bisque. This session will emphasize wheel throwing only as related to surface decoration and potters will be expected to bring pots/tiles to practice various techniques. At the end of this session, potters will have several new decorative skills in their repertoire to continue developing pots that are as unique as the potter who made them. Potters should be able to center and pull 2lbs of clay. [Min. 6, Max. 8]

INTRODUCTION TO WHEEL THROWING

If you've never tried the potter's wheel but have always wanted to, then this class is for you. If you've thrown on the wheel before but need a refresher or are new to Emerge, then this class is for you too! During this introductory class, you will learn the fundamentals necessary for throwing cylinders and bowls. The session will focus on techniques for centering, opening, pulling, trimming, and glazing; and, by the end of the session, students will have several finished pots to take home. Class size is restricted so students can get the technical instruction required to establish a good foundation for continued learning. This class is a prerequisite for continuing pottery classes. [Min. 4, Max. 6] Ages 16 and up or by special permission for senior project.

Continuing students will hone their skills at centering, opening, and pulling during this 6 week class. Projects are designed to help improve the fundamentals necessary for crafting well-made cylinders and bowls. Advanced skills such as increasing scale, pulling spouts, and attaching handles will be addressed to challenge potters who have more wheel experience. Each project will include glazing and surface decoration discussions. This class is project driven and will allow students to take home several functional pieces! Introduction to Wheel Throwing is a prerequisite to this class. [Min. 6, Max. 8]

The North Carolina Arts Council, Pitt County Arts Council, Greenville-Pitt Convention & Visitor's Bureau has named Carroll V. Dashiell, Jr. Artistic Director of a new series, The African American Music Series. Carroll Dashiell is a native of Washington, DC. A graduate of Howard University, with citations in Who's Who in Music and Down Beat Magazine, Carroll has been recognized for excellence in the music industry as a bassist, musical director/conductor and also as a composer/arranger. Affectionately known as CVD, he has been involved in academia for more than three decades serving as professor of music at the Saint Mary's College of Maryland, University of the District of Columbia and East Carolina University in North Carolina. CVD is the producer and writer of A Tribute to Motown Records, (a stage show and concert that celebrates some of the African-American's cultural contributions to the music industry, staged in the tradition of the famous touring Motown Review) that is selling out theaters and venues nation-wide. In addition to composing, writing and arranging, CVD is continuing to perform as jazz bassist and is very humbled to be the Founder and Director of the Dr. Billy Taylor Jazz Festival, named in honor of his mentor.

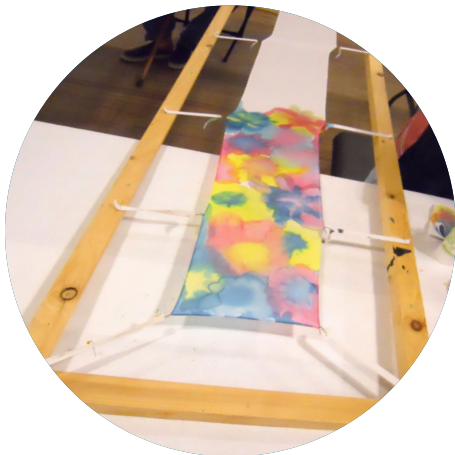
